- Build personal relationships with queer prisoners in indiana
- Focus on what inmates want and need rather than our political platform
- Distribute literature
- Raise awareness in a conflictual manner and otherwise among outside queers

#### WHAT YOU CAN DO

- Spread awareness of the importance of queer prisoner support
- Make writing to prisoners a part of your daily life
- Organize and attend fundraisers for incarcerated queers
- Make our daily lives as queers one of opposition to the state and its repression rather than asking for rights, agreeing to be compliant, and turning a blind eye to those of us who refuse or are never granted those rights
